BELOW IS THE LIST OF THE POINTS DISCUSSED DURING THE MEETING.

---

1. Make youth members play on Saturdays for Saturday youth league.
2. We are looking around 30 to 40 kids for this league. And looking for the parents to support us in this big step towards attracting youth towards cricket especially Leather ball cricket.
3. All the statistical (player registration, player profiles, scorecards etc) work for the Saturday Youth League (SYL) will be performed on AGCC website i.e. [www.atlantacricquet.org](http://www.atlantacricquet.org) / <http://cricclubs.com/AGCC>
4. We will be performing Evaluations for each of the kids who are eligible to play into Adult League.
5. Evaluations will be performed quarterly.
6. Youth League members are working on providing the evaluation dates upfront.

7. We need youth participation in the SYL to encourage them and advance them further in the cricketing field.
8. AGCC will be working to Organize camps for this youth.
9. Provided we have enough participation; we will also be working on (Atlanta Premier League) APL format for Youth.
10. We will also be working with the sponsors to get sponsorship for the best performing Kid so that we can send the kid for more training / coaching to India or other country.
11. We will also be inviting outside cricket team(s) to play in Atlanta.
12. Kid's age limit (criteria) to play in Adult League will be provided soon.
13. Either one of the Parent of each kid will need to be present on the ground for each game. This is mandatory.
14. We request each parent to convey our message to the parents of other kids who are interested to send their kids to play cricket.
15. AGCC will try and absorb all the costs associated with SYL unless it (cost) goes high.
16. We will also provide umpires for the SYL.

18. We will be uploading all the documentation related to Evaluations on our website.
19. Questions were asked regarding the evaluation criteria of AGCC vs National or SouthEast Regional evaluations.
  - 19.1 AGCC criteria is different compared to National / SouthEast Regional.
  - 19.2 AGCC criteria is to check if the youth is ready to play in Adult league. This is due to the restrictions from the schools to allow under 16 players to play in Adult League.
  - 19.3 AGCC needs to make sure that the youth is ready to play in adult league by testing the player on different aspects of the game from an adult league perspective.
20. Dr. Girish Pore will be working on providing a Medical evaluation form which needs to be signed by the parent of the youth.
