ground may not available if there are paid event is organized by the county, but number of occurrences of these events are very less (2-3) times a year, in this case we have a backup ground (Lithonia Park). The League is requesting to each team to adjust and coordinate if this situation comes.

League Start Date.

The 2020 league will start from 22 March 2020, however it may change based on grounds conditions and availability, since we need at least 8 grounds to run the schedule smoothly without any breaks. The Ramadan month will be considered in the schedule for the teams who are unable to play during Ramadan month. The league will start with 40/40 Format and later with 20/20.

Uniforms and Cricket Balls.

We started our process of procuring the reasonable cricket ball and uniform vendor for 2020. We will send a separate email for uniform design and sizes. The league will provide 15 uniforms free of cost, additional if required will be at actual cost, not more than \$28 per uniform.

• League Format.

The League will start with 40/40 format, each team will play with each other. After the league matches, there will be two groups (Premier and Star) for Playoffs. The rank 1-8 plays in Premier and 9-16 will be in Star league. The groups will be split based on the ranking at the end of the league matches.

The 20/20 format, we will be having 2 groups based on 40/40 league ranking for the league matches. After the League matches, there will Premier and Star Playoffs based on 20/20 League ranking, the format is similar 2019.

Proposed Budget for 2020

The 2020 budget is presented and passed at the BOD meeting, motion passed by DJ, Alpesh Patel, Ashish Patel, Amit Sood and Babar.

Miscelleanous Items/Recommendations

The recommendation came to have an official scorer for Playoffs. The league will get back on this.

Umpire fees to be published to all the teams before the start of the season. The league will do the needful.
