Rules of the Game

- There are totally 10 teams (Men) 5 teams (Ladies) participating in this league.
- The Captains of each team have to be announced 10 days prior to the start of the league. The Captains will be the point of contact for each team.
- All 10 can bat but there will be field restrictions for which only 8 players will be allowed on the field.
- All 8 can bat and there will be field restrictions for which only 8 players will be allowed on the field (WOMEN).
- Shuffling of players will be allowed after each over.
- Soft Ball Tennis TenX Balls shall be used for playing under arm cricket.
- 7 overs per innings for league matches, 8 overs per innings for Semis matches, 9 overs per innings for Finals shall be played.
- Bowling Restrictions No bowlers can be repeated. (Only Women Team 1 bowler can be repeated in Finals).

Rules of the Game

- There will be a bonus over where any runs scored will be counted as double and any wicket in that over will lead to 5 runs deduction from the total score.
- Bowling team will choose as when they want to take the Bonus Over.
- There will be a participation fees of Rs 1500** per head to book the ground,
 Trophies, Beverages, etc. At the end of the tournament if there is any excess
 then it will be returned back to the Team Captain. We will be sharing all
 expense and collection details at the end of the tournament in captains group.
- The matches will be held in the evening and timing for the matches will be as per the schedule updated on the CRICCLUBS APP. (Venue – St Joseph School – Wadala)
- Matches will be held from 3rd to the 11th January 2020.
- No kids will be allowed to participate as this is a ONLY parent League. Any team found getting an outside Parent / Player will be disqualified immediately.

Rules of the Game

- There shall be neutral umpires who will be hired to avoid any biasness or arguments. Umpires decision will be final at all times.
- This tournament is on private basis and DBIS is not involved in any way
 in the tournament whatsoever. Every parent should kindly take note of
 this. There are no organisers and its all done by cricket enthusiastic
 parents. Every parent has to guarantee their own safety while playing
 cricket in this league.
- The last date of giving entry for your teams including the payments is December 30th.
- Any team which is not present within 15 minutes of the start time then opponent will get a BYE.

Fielding Rules

- Total 8 Players on the Field. (MEN & WOMEN)
- 1 Player (Wicket Keeping), 1 Player (Bowling), 2 Players (Boundary), 2 Players (Between Boundary and Bowling Crease), 2 Players (Between Bowling and Batting Crease)
- Runs on Overthrow are there / Byes runs are there But No Leg Byes are applicable.
- Umpire Decision will be final decision in case of Run Outs.
- There are neutral umpires who will not belong to school or related to any player.
 These are hired from a third party.
- If the fielder catches the ball before the boundary and in an event any part of his body touches the net behind him, the batsman shall be given out.
- In an event of a No ball and Wide ball being bowled, Stumping and Run Outs rules shall be applicable.
- In an event of a Free Hit, Only Run out rule will be applicable.
- Bails once fallen down, than stumps has to be lifted to call for a run out.

Bowling Rules

- 7 Overs a Side for League Matches / 8 Overs a Side for Semis / 9 Overs a Side for Finals.
- Bowling Restrictions No bowlers can be repeated in any matches. (Except 1 over in Women's Final match)
- WIDE and NO BALLS runs will be counted. Umpires Decision will be final.
- There will be a bonus over where any runs scored will be counted as double and any wicket in that over will lead to 5 runs deduction. **Bowling** team will choose as and when they want to take the Bonus Over during the span of the match.
- If a bowler crosses the Popping Crease completely the it will be called as a **NO Ball.**
- The call for Fast ball will be of Batsman, to be concurred by the umpire. Umpire decision will be final in this regards. Incse the Umpire declares the ball as a fast ball, it will be declared as a **NO Ball**.
- Any delivery more than one bounce will be a dead delivery and umpires call will be a
 final one in case of any delivery to be called a dead ball. Unless the second bounce of
 the ball is falling behind the batting crease or behind the batsman after he has played
 the shot.
- Soft Ball Tennis and under arm cricket.
- No Roll Over of Arm is allowed during bowling.

Bowling Rules

- Dead Ball i.e. (A ball bowled with more than one bounce) but bowled along side the
 wide line or outside the wide line as per the umpire's decision shall be called as A Wide
 Ball, same rule applies for a NO BALL.
- A 50:50 ratio of the Pitch shall be prepared. Hence the bowler needs to bowl the first bounce of the ball ahead of the line drawn. In case the ball pitches before the line drawn, then the ball will be called as a **NO Ball** and all the standard No Ball rules shall be applicable at that time.
- If a Bowler bowls a ball with first bounce after the 60:40 Line but if it again bounces before the batting crease and before the batsman taking his shot, then the same shall be called as a Dead Ball.
- In the process a Dead Ball goes outside the Wide Lines, it will be called as a Wide.
- A box will be marked up for the bowling run-up. Any ball bowled using the length outside the marked Box up shall be called as **NO Ball**.
- Hiding the ball while bowling allowed.
- No side arm bowling is allowed; where the bowler's hand is above the waist line. The
 Leg umpire shall give the first warning and the ball will be called as Dead Ball but post
 that if the bowler repeats the action, the ball will be called as a No Ball.
- If the Batsman Charges towards the ball, **NO Ball** shall not be given.

Bowling Rules

- No Ball shall be called if any part of the bowler touches any part of the Bowling stumps during the bowling action.
- Any ball bowled over the waist, if the Batsman is charging and out of his crease, then it shall not be called as a No Ball.
- If the bowler touches any line at the bowling and side crease, it will be called as a
 No Ball.
- If the Wicket Keeper collects the ball or touches the stumps before or in front of the stumps while keeping during the time when the ball is bowled, it will be called as a No Ball.

Batting Rules

- In League and Semis matches a CAP of 36 runs per player (MEN) and CAP of 24 runs per player (WOMEN) will be there and the player can come again and bat in case of all out (FIFO applies). No CAP in runs in Finals. (Actual runs in Bonus over will be counted in CAP of individual players.
- No retirement allowed, except with the permission of the opponent captain.
- No runners allowed unless serious injuries, and if there is a requirement of a runner then it has to be informed before hand to the opponent captain.
- The last man batting rules shall not be applicable.

Boundaries Rule

- If the ball touches the net behind the bowler directly then it's a 6 runs.
- If the ball touches any part of the net and reaches the boundary line than it will be considered as 4 runs.
- If the ball goes outside the net after the bowling crease it will be 2 Runs declared and before the bowling crease it will be 1 run declared.
