

Matches must be played on the date specified by the league schedule published by Executive committee on Cric Clubs website. Matches can only be rescheduled under exceptional circumstances and Executive committee will take the final decision.

Games should not be called off in advance even if there are chances that it may rain. Umpires should be present at the start time to make the decision about the match. In case of heavy rain, the game can be called off with agreement by two team captains, umpires and OC 1 hour prior to the official start time.

EC and OC teams will take the final decision if any exceptional cases that are not covered in this document.

## **Rain affected league matches**

If the game cancelled without single ball bowled the points will be shared to both teams.

- 1. In case of if any rain forecast before the start of the game before starting the match itself, umpires, game team captains and OC will determine the max number of overs for that match based on the measured conditions. Minimum 10 overs (in each innings) game must be played to get the result. For over reduction in a match, a reduction of 1 over/ 4 mins basis should be carried out considering the overall time (180 minutes) required for the match. Ex: If 40 minutes of the match time can't be utilized due to rain then 10 overs will be reduced for that match.
- 2. Once the match has started and stopped due to rain or for any reason, extra time will be added to the schedule time to complete the game on the same day if there is a possibility.
- 3. If the game abandoned before second innings started and 1 & 2 options are not possible, the points will be shared.
- 4. If the game stopped when second innings in progress, the affected games will be conducted on upcoming Saturday at 7:30 AM at the same ground. Teams will need to play regular scheduled games at that ground once this rescheduled innings is completed, Also, both the teams will have an option to complete the game during the weekday if they are willing to. If a team does not show up, then the penalty of "Unavailability/No-show" rule will be applied. And the opponent team will get a walkover win with 2 points. If teams are available and the game is not completed on or before following Saturday with any reason, the points will be shared to both teams.

## Knockout games

Once the match has started and stopped due to any reason, extra time will be added to the schedule time to complete the game on the same day if there is a possibility. Otherwise, that match will be continued on the next available day from where the match was stopped on the first day. No re-match will be played even the game stopped before 10 overs of play.
