





Rule 3: During league, if a captain is unavailable for a particular period but he wants to play his matches in the end of the season, in such case committee will support the captain. However, in the end when that captain's matches are scheduled and he is unavailable on those days, then its mandatory for the captain to choose standing captain option just for the sake of league not getting extended.

Rule 4: In a particular match both teams will have to use same kind of ball (old/new) to make it even for both teams.

Rule 5: If suppose a captain doesn't want to continue leading his side because of his upcoming unavailability, he can opt for standing captain option if he feels he can come back and lead his team for remaining matches. But if he wants to step down from captaincy for rest of the season fully then his team will be handed over to a new captain to continue and if that new captain qualifies for the knockout stages, then he will be allowed to play knock out matches unlike before.

Rule 6: During knock out stages, only ONE match can be scheduled by default. But if captains agree to play second match, then second match can be played.
