

## **FC Calgary Cricket Tournament Rules**

**Date:** July 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2022

**Time:** 8am onwards

**Location: Rotary Challenger Park, Westwinds NE** 

## **Format:**

- 2 groups of 4 teams each
- Each team to play 3 matches
- Top 2 teams from each group to advance to semifinals

## **General Rules**

- Each team will consist of 11 players, with 11 players on the field in a game.
  Only registered players are allowed to participate in this tournament.
- Each Group match time limit: 40 minutes. Captains need to make sure that their bowling (5 overs) is completed within 20 minutes.
- Each Group match will be of 5 overs limit of 1 over per bowler
- Final will be of 5 overs, limit of 1 over per bowler
- Winner of each match will be awarded 2 points
- In case of a tie result in first group matches, 1 point will be awarded to each team. However, in the Semi-Finals and Finals, match will be decided on a super over
- Each Team is required to provide two umpires to their allotted games,
  Failure to do so will result in deduction of 1 point.

- If 2 teams finish on same points at the end of group stage, team with higher Net Run Rate (NRR) will qualify for the Semi-Final
- In order to be eligible to play the Play-offs (Semi-Finals and Finals), player has to play minimum of 2 games during the league stage.
- A Runner will not be allowed in a match for a batsman
- Use of fiber bat is not allowed, teams are required to bring their own bats
- If a team does not show up or is missing a few players, a grace time of 10 minutes will be allowed before walkover will be awarded to opposing team.
  A minimum of 7 players is required to start a match
- If the game is started and a player joins in late (for any reason), following conditions shall apply:
  - Player joined after 1 over has been bowled That player cannot bowl in that match, however, can bat after the fall of the 4<sup>th</sup> wicket.
- Umpire's decision shall stand FINAL. In case of a dispute, Umpires can consult with Taskforce committee (Fahad Farooq and Neil D'Mello) if required. Taskforce Committee's decision will be Final
- Umpire's decision shall not be challenged in any case.
- Runs from Byes, Leg byes, Wides, no-balls, overthrows are allowed. One bouncer is allowed per over provided it is below shoulder height. Any ball above shoulder height will be deemed a wide ball
- A full toss above the waist will be deemed a No-Ball. There will be free hit awarded to batting team for any No-Ball
- Team Captains are responsible to gather their team players on ground as per given schedule 10 minutes ahead of their game time and be ready for the toss.
- Team's captains are responsible for ensuring that the game is played within the spirit of the game
- Players and teams shall not use rude or abusive language
- Tournament organizing committee reserves the right to change or modify the format, rules etc. or time at any time for any unforeseen reason

## **Covid Specific Restrictions**

Maximum of 24 players will be allowed on the field at a time (including

fielding team, batsmen and Umpires)

• Any player that does not feel well is requested to stay home and not participate.
