Bay Environmental Strategies, Inc. (BAY), is providing this information as an addendum to the above referenced General Permit request previously submitted. Based on our discussion and information obtained during our on-site meeting on September 19, 2013, modifications have been made to the proposed project to bring it into compliance with the minimization criteria.

The location of the wetland crossing has been moved to the narrowest point of the wetland as delineated. The proposed path will still be 15 wide, but will only cross 37 feet of wetland, versus the 55 feet of wetland as previously proposed. The new total permanent wetland disturbance is estimated to be 555 sq/ft (0.012 acres). The attached *Figure 1- Project Overview Map*, illustrates the project location and configuration.

The path construction will be the same as previously proposed, and will consist of first grading and leveling the existing ground surface. A base layer consisting of 8 to 10 inches of gravel will be placed on the ground surface, with approximately 3 inches of crusher dust/screenings placed on top of the gravel. An estimated 20 cubic yards of material will be placed within the wetland. The new wetland crossing location will still utilize an 8" HDPE culvert that will be placed across the path at the existing ground level. A cross section view of the project is provided in the attached *Figure 2, Project Detail*.
