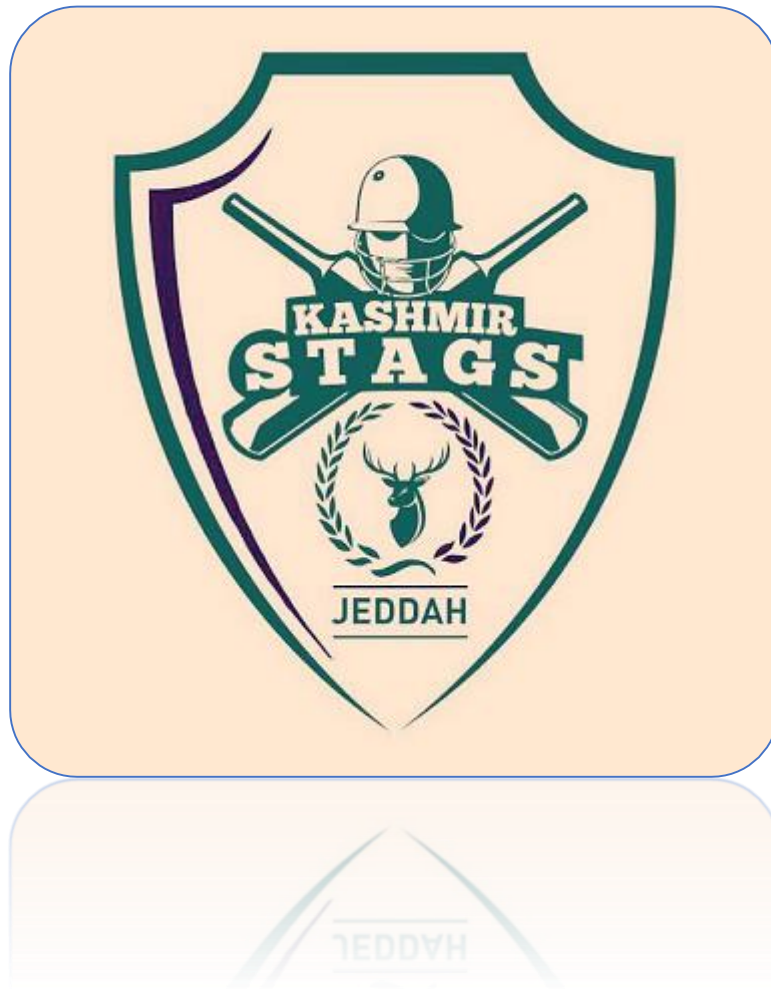

Kashmir Stags Rules & Regulations

CRICKET CLUB: The club shall be called **Kashmir Stags Cricket Club**.

MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE:

The Management of the Club shall consist of the Manager, the Captain and the Vice-Captain. Each Officer shall be elected at the General Meeting.

2.1 The Committee shall have the power to fill any vacancies which may occur in it. Re-Election can be initiated taking in view club's majority opinion.

2.2 Any member of the club shall have the privilege of attending Executive Committee meetings. Such a member may not take part in the meeting except at the Managers invitation and may be excluded at the discretion of the Executive Committee.

SELECTION COMMITTEE:

The Selection Committee shall comprise:-

- a) The elected team captain, vice-captain and manager shall be nominated for positions based on vote from each team player.
- b) Team selection of playing XI shall be concluded by Captain.

CLUB SECRETARY Cum TREASURER:

The Club Secretary shall:

3.1 Maintain the records of the Club along with the financial records.

3.2 To control and administer the club's funds and assets.

3.5 Keep and maintain the financial books and records of the Club. The collection of the match fees and updating the match fee/availability book accordingly.

THE MANAGER:

The Club Manager Shall:

4.1 Be responsible for arranging all playing fixtures of the Club.

4.2 Generally correspond with opposition clubs and with cricket associations of which the Club is a member.

4.3 Record, maintain and update the team and individual players stats.

4.4 To apply the Club Rules and to interpret and determine any matter related thereto. To decide any matter to which the Club Rules do not apply. To adjudicate on any matter in dispute.

4.5 To administer all matters affecting the affairs of the club.

4.6 Arrange meetings of the Committee and also upon the written request of executive members of the Committee. Manager shall be bound to call a meeting if requested to do so in writing by at least three members of the Club.

4.7 To keep comprehensive minutes of all general and committee meetings.

4.8 Responsible for availability status for the next match of each player.

CAPTAIN OF THE XI:

The Captain of the XI shall:

5.1 Select the team for each fixture. In doing this he shall take account of the number of fixtures in the season and availability, performance and sportsmanship of the players.

5.2 To act as a liaison between the management and the team.

Alongside this there are a number of specific roles that captains perform. These include:

- Ensuring a constant flow of information between the management and team.
- Leading by example.
- Inspiring and motivating teammates.
- Conducting oneself in a professional manner before, during and after the game with respect to teammates, opponents and officials.
- Being effective communicator.
- Remaining positive (regarding performance, potential and outcomes).
- Controlling one's emotions.

VICE CAPTAIN:

- 6.1** The responsibility of the vice-captain is to assume the responsibilities of the Captain for any matches where the Captain is not playing.
- 6.2** For any match in which they are playing, the vice-captain shall be responsible for ensuring that the boundary markers.

THE CLUB RULES

- 7.1** Every member shall receive a copy of, be bound by and submit to the Club Rules.
- 7.2** No alteration or addition to the Rules shall be made save by majority vote of full members who are present and vote at a general meeting. A copy of the motion proposing such an alteration or addition shall be sent with the notice of the general meeting at which it is to be considered.
- 7.3** Every player shall be bound to abide by Red Zone Policy. Red Zone Policy applies to players performing below par. At the end of every game two bowlers and two batsmen shall be listed in Red Zone which will be notified prior to match. Red Zone will be evaluated after every 2 matches and out of the four elected red Zone players one bowler and one batsman shall be dropped for the next match so that the bench players can be given a fair chance for play. It is not compulsory for Redzone players to be on field but they are expected to be on field to support their team even if they are not playing. Those players who will show up to support their team inspite of not playing will get priority in future selections. Red Zone players will also show their availability for the match irrespective of being in Red Zone.
- 7.4** Any player found mis-behaving with a fellow player, using foul language or acts or any kind of in-discipline on field shall be appropriately punished. The minimum level of punishment shall be suspension for 1 match. Expert comments by everyone on field are to be refrained. In case of suspension it is compulsory for the player to come to field for the duration of suspended matches.
- 7.5** Every month players are supposed to contribute 50 SAR non-refundable before 15th of every month for 6 months and then after either the fund contribution amount might be reduced or not required depending on the fund status. Failing to do so without any genuine cause, player shall be dropped until dues are duly cleared.
- 7.6** Any decision on field by the captain has to respected. If found the decision were inappropriate, they can be discussed off-field after the match. Action will be initiated against anyone failing to do so.

7.7 Suspension, disciplinary actions or red zone players shall be decided by the committee.

7.8 It is compulsory for any member suspended for any reason to be present on field for the tenure of suspended matches.

7.9 Any players facing any issue shall discuss it directly with the committee. In case the committee fails to resolve the issue then only the issue can be discussed with a fellow player. Direct interaction with all team members regarding team or personal issues shall result in suspension. Suspension in such case will be 2 matches.

7.10 Any player committing to play and then is unavailable on field without any valid reason shall be suspended for a tenure of two matches. In case of failing to comply with the commitment, the player shall intimate management 48 hours prior to the match about his unavailability in order to avoid suspension.

7.11 Any player non-conforming to umpiring shall bear a suspension of one match. Also, it will be the responsibility of the player to arrange for his replacement if he is unable to go for umpiring. The management holds no responsibility to arrange for replacements for any player for umpiring.

7.12 The manager shall reside at captain's position in case if both captain and vice-captain are unavailable.

7.13 No player shall be allowed to play without a complete safety gear. Failing to do so, the management holds power either to bench or suspend the player.
