General Rules:

Tournament will be conducted in Hard tennis ball (No Tape).

- Cricclubs will be used for scoring.
- Captains are responsible for updating their team in cric clubs before Friday 02/24/2023.
- All player should have their latest picture uploaded in criclubs before the game day.
- Players without pictures in cricclubs will not be allowed to play.
- Captains to verify the playing 8 using cric clubs to make sure only the players in the roster are playing before start of every game. No queries will be entertained after the first ball of the game is bowled.
- Batting teams should provide leg umpires.
- Boundary would be 30 yards only.
- Maximum 6 overs per side.
- Teams should compete their 6 overs in 20 mins.
- Maximum 8 players per side.
- One new ball per match will be used (not per innings).
- When a batsman hits the ball, If the ball directly pitches outside of the 30 yard box is OUT.
- When a batsman hits the ball, If a fielder attempts to catch (touches any part of his body) but the ball goes over 30 yard without pitching the batting team will be awarded 4 runs. Batsman will continue to play.
- When a batsman hits the ball, it touches the ground atleast once before crossing the 30 yard woud be awarded boundary (4 runs only).
- Running between the wickets is allowed.
- No LBW or legbyes. No RUN-OUT in leg byes.
- Minimum 4 bowlers have to bowl per side.
- 2 bowlers can bowl maximum of 2 overs.
- One bouncer allowed per over.
- A player shall represent one team only.
- Every tied game will result in super over until we have a winner.
- No super sub.
- No last man batting.
- Every team has to carry its own playing kit
- Umpires decision will be final.
- CHUCKING Umpires will rule the ball bowled by Bowler as NO ball. If the bowler continues to chuck and cannot bowl properly he will be banned the entire series.
- Players are requested to play at their own risk. Organizers are not responsible for player injuries that happens in the tournament. Personal Health insurance needs to be used.
- Every teams has to report 15 mins before the match. 1 over would be reduced for team that arrives late for every 5 mins. If a team arrives late more than 10 min, the opposite team shall be

awarded the points with NRR calculation. (Team arrived late will be conisered scoring 0 runs in six overs with winning team scoring 1 runs in 1st ball).

- All NO-Balls will be awarded FREE-HIT. Batsman can hit the ball directly outside of the 30 yard in a FREE-HIT and will be awarded boundry (4 only). Batsman continue to play.
- All rules mentioned above are specific to this tournament.
- ICC rules will be applied for all other rules that are not specified here.
- In matters of doubt not covered by the tournament rules, the decision of the Match Umpires and Match Referee will be final and binding upon all concerned.
- The match committee reserves the right to amend these rules at any time if it considers such an action to be in the best interests of the tournament.
- All match rules shall be subject to weather/ ground conditions and the playing terms shall be modified suitably.
- The match committee reserves the right to amend these rules at any time if it considers such an action to be in the best interests of the tournament.
- All match rules shall be subject to weather/ ground conditions and the playing terms shall be modified suitably.
- No Breaks between games.
- Teams resposibility to arrange food/water and other needs.
- Teams are not allowed to leave the ground under any circumstance.

. Format:

- Maximum of 16 teams divided in to 4 groups.
- Please refer to cricclubs for fixtures and other details.
- Each team will play 3 league games.
- Top 2 teams with highest points in each group will qualify for knock outs
- If more teams have same points NRR would be taken into consideration.
- QF's and Semi finals fixtures are as follows.
