

## 2021 PCA T-20 Tournament Rules

### Tournament Structure:

1. Format - T20
2. Grounds – PCA 6.
3. Day-Night Matches
4. Game Start time is 5:30 PM
5. Max. Number of teams – 4 (DCCC, PICC, Plano Tigers & PCC)
6. Teams should play in coordinated colored clothing. Multiple colors in the playing XI are not allowed.
7. White Balls to be used throughout this tournament.

### Laws & Bylaws

8. Current ICC playing conditions will be followed.

### Umpiring:

9. The two non-playing teams of the week will send one umpire each to the game.
10. The umpires don't have to be certified as long as they are playing members of any club in PCA.
11. Hired Certified umpires are allowed.
12. Umpires need to be dressed in Dark Clothing

### Player Eligibility:

13. Only Players registered with their respective PCA Club is eligible to play. If in special cases of emergency, etc. any other non PCA club player being substituted must be approved by Tournament Coordinator.
14. Please respect the game and have fun. In the interest of fair play, any breach of rules brought to the attention of Umpire on the ground, could result in the player being ruled ineligible for the game.

**CricClubs Scoring:**

15. All games must be scored in CricClubs.
16. Prior to the game, always verify if you have the latest CricClubs app downloaded on your smartphone (ios or android).
17. The new version of app will lock the scorecard immediately after a game.
18. Teams as you always do, if you don't find a player name, use available player name and proceed with scoring. If it's a new club member, request scorecard unlock to update. If it's a player from another club, he doesn't get the stats from the game.

**Super Sub**

19. Teams are allowed 12 players per game. Team can designate 1 player as a super sub at time of Toss. Super Sub will be eligible to bowl or bat in place of a player in the official 11.
20. Only 11 men allowed to field or bat. 10 wickets constitute an innings.
21. No restrictions on the substitution fielder eligibility to field at any time during game.
22. Teams may choose to play without a super sub with designated 11.

**Ground Setup:**

23. During PCA Tournament the following ground setup rules apply.
24. Ground setup is responsibility of both playing teams.
25. One Team will mark boundaries. The other Team will mark inner circle.
26. Ground clean-up responsibility belongs to both teams. That includes picking and dumping trash, removing flags and cones.
27. Each team responsible for stumps and bails for one end.
28. All teams are advised to carry the ground setup kit (Flags, cones, stumps, bails, chalk, tape measure) etc. for all games.
