


INFORMATION & RULE BOOK

All matches will be played with "NIVIA" hard tennis balls. Rustic Cricket Club (RCC) will provide balls and wickets for all the matches.

The matches will be played at Rustic Cricket Ground @ 999 East Henrietta Road, Rochester and Genesee Valley Park @ 1000 East River Road, Rochester.



Rustic 15th Annual Cricket Tournament

Tournament Format:

- Total number of teams are limited to 21
- Last year champions are directly qualified as seed 1 team for Round 16
- Remaining 20 teams will play League Round games according to the draw
- League Round winners (10 teams) will be qualified for Round 16. Team seeding is based on run rate: Seed 2 to Seed 11
- The losing teams from League Round will play Elimination Round to qualify for Round 16
- The losing team positions for the Elimination Round are based on League Round run rate
- Seed 12 to Seed 16 teams will be decided based on Elimination Round winning team's run rate
- All Round 16 games are Knockouts. 8 winning teams from Round 16 will be qualified for Quarterfinals
- Seeding for Quarterfinals are based on Round 16 game's run rate only
- 4 winning teams from Quarterfinals will be qualified for Semifinals.
- Seeding for Semifinals are based on Quarterfinals game's run rate only
- All the teams need to publish their team roster along with email ids (minimum 12 players and max 18 players), by Wednesday midnight (Aug 01st 2018). This information is necessary for online scoring
- Publishing the roster is mandatory for all the teams. Teams without roster are NOT considered for the draws on Thursday (Aug 02nd 2018)

Tournament Specific Rules:

- 8 Overs per innings for all the games
- 2 Overs max per bowler allowed.
- No Power Play and at any time of the innings, total of 4 fielders are allowed outside the 30 yard circle.
- Field Umpire decision is final in all matches
- No Leg Byes and LBWs.
- One ball per over above the shoulder and below the head height will be allowed.
- Over the waist full toss will be a No Ball.
- Stepping outside (of the front / of the side line) of the crease is No Ball
- There will be free hit for any kind of no ball
- By runner will be allowed only if the on field umpires and the opposition captain agree.
- On Tie situation- Super Over will be used to determine the winner. (3 batsmen + 1 bowler)
- Seeding of teams during all the tournament games is based on
 - Run rate up to 4 decimal points
 - If Run rate is exactly same up to 4 decimal points then team with less no of wickets will be qualified as winner
 - If the run rate and number of wickets fell are same then team with max no of sixes and boundaries will be qualified as winner
 - o If all above clauses are same then team with less no of extras will be qualified as winner
 - In case of situation where all above clauses exactly same, then Super Over will be used to determine the winner. (3 batsmen + 1 bowler).
 - In case of Super over tie situation, then no of wickets, sixes, boundaries and extras will be considered to determine the winner

- Though completive cricket is appreciated and expected, use of profanity, physical aggression and unruly behavior of any kind will result in disqualification of the team. The decision will be made by the on field umpires in consultation with the organizing committee.
- All the other ICC rules will be implemented unless explicitly mentioned in any of the points above. In that case the rules listed above will take precedence. Tournament Organizers will have the final call in imposing the guidelines based on the situation at hand.

Team Registration and Release Forms Sign up:

Upon arrival each team has to visit the registration desk and sign a Release Forms

Every player will have to sign a release form waiving any claims against Rustic Village Apartments, any groups or individuals associated with this event, and the organizers of this event for injury or illness, including death that may result directly or indirectly from their participation in this event.

Code of Conduct:

- Foul/abusive language and insulting/threatening behavior WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. This includes the use of offensive nicknames.
- Only the Team Captain is allowed to raise an issue with the umpire. No one else is allowed to stall the game by arguing, criticizing etc.
- No alcohol/drugs are allowed on the ground. Persons under the influence of drugs/alcohol and/or exhibiting inappropriate behavior will be asked to leave.
- Rustic Cricket Tournament organizing committee and volunteers have the authority to request proper behavior, or, if there is no response to this request, you may be asked to leave the premises.
