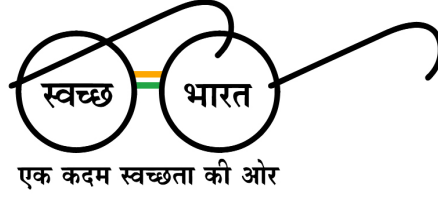
Cricket's boundary exists only in the field, as a game it transcends National Boundaries. It transcends social, racial and cultural barriers. It is a valued part of India's heritage and way of life. In India cricket is treated with reverence, almost like a religion. It is a game which brings together the diverse citizens of this country.

The Delhi Mandal T-20 cricket challenge is an effort by Shri Manoj Tiwari Ji to promote the cricket sport in the national capital, an effort to inculcate the spirit of sportsmanship. In the previous edition of this tournament the Yamuna Challenge Trophy 2016, Shri Manoj Tiwari Ji had mentioned how he believes that there are cricketing stars in the by-lanes of the capital, all they need is a platform to showcase their talent. In order to give the young generation of Delhi a podium to exhibit their cricketing skills, this tournament will bring together 280 teams/mandals from 7 constituencies of the capital, who will battle it out on the field to attain the title of the "Champion".

Inspired by our honourable Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji's Khelo India Initiative, the Yamuna Challenge Trophy 2017, will assemble citizens of all the Mandals of Delhi in a mega sporting event which will commence on the 21st of November 2017.

The objective of the Yamuna Challenge Trophy 2017 is to enhance entertainment value of the game. To protect the ethical values of the game and to motivate members of each constituency of New Delhi to come forward, participate and enjoy the game.





After looking at the deteriorating state of the environment of Delhi and Yamuna, Shri Manoj Tiwari ji was deeply moved, he wanted to do something in his own capacity which could help build a platform where the young generation of the city understood the importance of cleanliness, what better than the sporting religion of our country- Cricket.

With this thought process We bring to you the Yamuna Challenge trophy 2017, a tournament started in 2016 under the able vision of shri Manoj Tiwari Ji to clean the Yamuna river. This tournament will bring together thousands of youth of the 7 different constituencies of the capital who will then work together to achieve the ultimate goal set out by our honourable prime minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji - **Swachh Bharat**. The participants of this tournament will engage in activities related to clean the river Yamuna as well as other areas. This tournament will also prove to be a platform for young talented boys to show their skills on the field and take their first step to achieve their dreams of making a sporting career.

Yamuna Challenge Trophy 2017:



The Yamuna Challenge Trophy 2017, is back after a successful run last year. Surpassing the standard of the previous edition this tournament will be played in two levels This year, The Intra - Constituency and the Inter - Constituency.

Intra - Constituency:

Intra constituency refers to one constituency and the initial matches will be played among the mandals of one Constituency till two mandals are selected for the Inter Constituency (Round of 16). In each constituency, the mandals will play matches against each other which will be generated by the draw of lots with each constituency undergoing the Knock out draw (Round of 64).

Inter - Constituency:

Inter constituency refers to the seven constituencies all together, playing amongst each other. The two winners (Mandals) from the intra Constituency round will now play against each other, in the knock out format of 16. I.e. a total of 14 teams (2 from each constituency) will play against each other. Matches will be decided on the draw of lots.

Round of 16:

2 mandals from each constituency will play in the round of 16. The matches will be decided on the draw of lots, in a knock out format.

Quarter Finals:

8 Mandals from the round of 16 will qualify for the QF's. The matches will be decided by the draw of lots.

Semi-Finals:

Two semifinals will be played between the top 4 teams from the quarter finals.

Semi-finals 1: Winner of Quarter-finals 1 vs Winner of Quarter-finals 2

Semi-finals 2: Winner of Quarter-finals 3 vs Winner of Quarter-finals 4

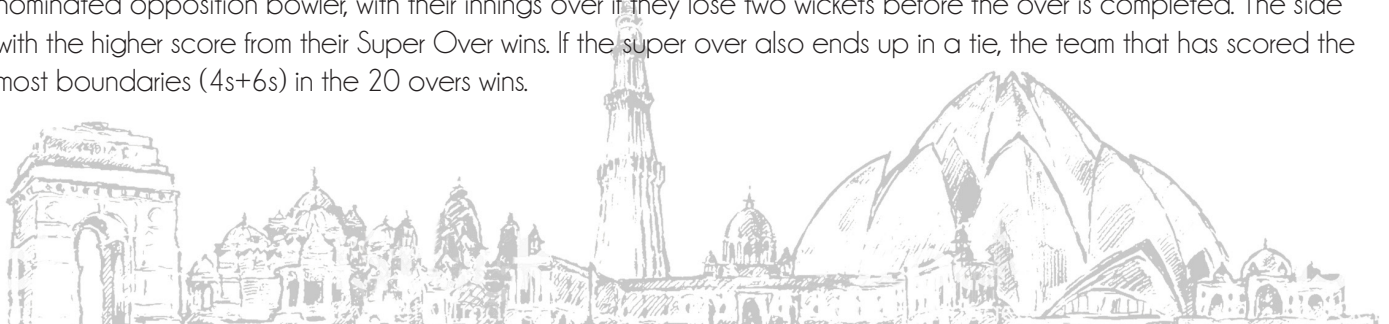

A final match will be played to decide the champion of the Yamuna Challenge Trophy 2017

Tied Matches

If the match is tied, then the teams will play a **super over**.

If the match ends with the scores tied and there must be a winner, the tie is broken with a one over per side Eliminator or Super Over: Each team nominates three batsmen and one bowler to play a one-over per side "mini-match". The team which bats second in the match bats first in the Super Over. In turn, each side bats one over bowled by the one nominated opposition bowler, with their innings over if they lose two wickets before the over is completed. The side with the higher score from their Super Over wins. If the super over also ends up in a tie, the team that has scored the most boundaries (4s+6s) in the 20 overs wins.





Playing Conditions:

The organizing committee will follow the standard of ICC/BCCI for playing conditions. However, the dimensions of playing arena at certain grounds can be smaller than stipulated ICC/BCCI norms but shall still apply as a part of playing conditions. The team management is advised to speak to the technical committee for any clarifications with regards to playing conditions.

Eligibility Criteria:

- The player should be bona-fide resident of the mandal, he represents in the tournament.
- Any player who has played in first class cricket like Ranji trophy, inter university, U-19 national championship etc., will not be allowed to participate unless he has retired 6 years from professional cricket before this championship.
- No Age Bar (The player should be medically fit to participate in the tournament)
- Players will not be allowed to wear shoes with spikes during the match.

Squads:

Size of Squads:

Each squad shall comprise of 14 players, and a maximum of 2 officials (Coach + Manager).

The final list of players as well as the registration fee should be submitted to the organising committee prior to the deadline of registration.

Replacement of players:

Teams will be permitted to replace a player only due to injury or medical reasons, on subject to the approval of the technical committee.

Clothing and Equipment:

One t-shirt will be provided to all the players in the Knock-out Round 1 (Intra Constituency) and Upper + Lower along with one T-shirt will be provided to all the quarter-finalists.

Each participating team is responsible for the provision of its own team kit (Bat, Pads, Gloves, Helmets etc.)

All the teams are required to be attired in the respective team uniform in all the matches, official functions and official photograph sessions.

Arrival time:

Participating teams are expected to report the umpires 60 minutes prior to the start of the match. Team Manager, coach and captain are required to be present at the designated place for the meeting with the organizing committee whenever required or asked for.

Participation Fees:

Entry fee of the tournament: INR 11,000 per team.

Financial Implications:

The organizing committee is responsible for the following costs based on a maximum of 14 players and 2 officials per team:

Cost of Conducting the matches

- Provision of balls, stumps, bails etc
- All match related costs
- One time refreshment for 14 players and 2 officials per team per match.
- One T-shirt per player and official per team.

The following will be arranged by the participating team:

- Playing Kit and equipment
- Cost of Transportation
- Medical and Personal Insurance
- Cost of all minor and major Medical Treatment

Official Commitments:

- Press Conference
- Pre-Tournament Meeting (If any)
- Opening Ceremony
- Closing Ceremony

Media Conference & Media Relations:

A media conference will be held for the tournament. Organising Committee will notify and Request for participation. The participants and officials are requested to cooperate with the PRO of the tournament for better media Coverage.

Format:

The format of the competition is defined in the playing conditions, as per the ICC Twenty-20 norms. In case of any doubts the Team Manager is requested to have a briefing with the Umpire prior to the match.

Rules of Play:

The rules of play are in accordance with the ICC stipulations Twenty-20

Team Awards shall be as follows:

- (i) Winner : 5 Lakh Award and Winner Trophy
- (ii) Runner-UP : 3 Lakh Award
- (iii) The two teams knocked out in the Semi Finals will receive a award of INR 60,000 each
- (iv) All the teams knocked out in the quarter final will receive a award of INR 50,000 each

Additional Awards:

Man of the Series

Best bowler of the series (Highest wicket taker of the tournament)

Best Batsman of the series (Highest scorer of the tournament)





Rules of Twenty- 20:

1. There will be a maximum of 20 overs.
2. A bowler can bowl a maximum of four overs in an innings.
3. Free Hit: If the bowler bowls a no-ball, the next ball shall be a free Hit. For this ball, the batsman is not given out by anyway in the cricket rules apart from being a run-out. The captain cannot change field setting and it will be the same as the previous ball.
4. No 30 yard circle & no fielding restrictions, only 5 fielders can field on the leg side at any point of time.

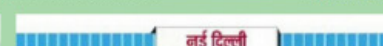
