Playoffs Format

- There will be a total of 12 teams participating in the league.
- Each team will play 10 round-robin games, with one team being avoided, chosen by a randomizer.
- The top 2 teams at the end of the league stage will directly qualify for the semi-finals.
- Semi-final games are played at neutral venues.
- Teams ranked from 3rd to 6th will qualify for the wild card round (quarter-finals), with the higher-ranked team hosting the games.
 - The wildcard matchups will be as follows:
 - E1: 3rd place vs 6th place
 - E2: 4th place vs 5th place
- The winner of E1 will play in the semi-finals against the team ranked 2nd, while the winner of E2 will face the team ranked 1st in the semi-finals.

Notes: The same format is used for both Premier and Super Leagues.
