# Terminology and Definitions

---

<b>Term</b>	<b>Definition or Meaning</b>
<b>Ad Hoc Committee</b>	Committee formed for a specific task or objective, and dissolved after the completion of the task or achievement of the objective.
<b>Appellate Committee</b>	Committee appointed by the Board of Directors to hear appeals on decisions adjudicated by the Judiciary Committee.
<b>By-Laws</b>	Rules adopted by the WCL that regulate and govern its day-to-day affairs.
<b>Code Of Conduct</b>	Set of rules for WCL outlining the behavior and responsibilities of proper practices for an individual or organization and sanctions for breaking these rules.
<b>Code of Ethics</b>	A set of principles and procedures that govern the behavior of WCL Officials.
<b>Constitution</b>	Supreme Laws that govern the overall existence and functions of WCL.
<b>Director</b>	A director of the WCL is a member of the Board of Directors.
<b>Executive Committee</b>	Committee elected by the membership to manage the day-to-day operations of WCL.
<b>Good Standing</b>	The status of a club or member of the WCL, who is current with the payment of dues, is not under suspension and who has satisfied all other duties, obligations and conditions of membership.
<b>Hall of Fame Committee</b>	Committee within the Executive Committee charged with evaluating candidates for induction into WCL Hall Of Fame.
<b>Judiciary Committee</b>	Committee authorized by the Constitution to deal with complaints against players and club officials.
<b>Nominations and Electoral Committee</b>	Committee appointed by the President to screen, assess and evaluate potential candidates for election to the Board of Directors.

<b>Term</b>	<b>Definition or Meaning</b>
<b>Officer</b>	An officer is a member of the Executive Committee and who is duly elected by the members of the Organization.
<b>Organization's Property</b>	All property acquired by the WCL through gift, grants, donations, devise, bequeath. This includes intellectual property, real property and all tangible property.
<b>Player of the Week Committee</b>	Committee chaired by the Statistician to determine the Player (s) of the Week.
<b>Playing Conditions</b>	Rules and conditions under which the league games and competitions are played within WCL.
<b>Umpires Association</b>	Association authorized by the WCL Constitution and elected by the membership to give autonomy to umpires while still operating under the WCL Constitution.
