



WMCB 2021 T20 Competition Rules

1. League

- 1.1. All teams will participate in the T20 League competition.
- 1.2. Team will be split into two conferences:

- 1.3. Each team will play nine (9) league matches.
- 1.4. If a league game ends with the scores level, the teams will play a super over.

2. Playoffs

2.1. Qualification

2.1.1. The right to play in the playoffs is determined as follows:

- Twelve (12) teams will qualify for the playoffs:
 - Top Six (6) from each conference
 - i) Top two (2) from each conference will be awarded Bye to semifinal.
 - ii) Remaining Four (4) team will compete with each other in play off

2.1.2. During group stages team will be ranked within the group based on the below ranking system:

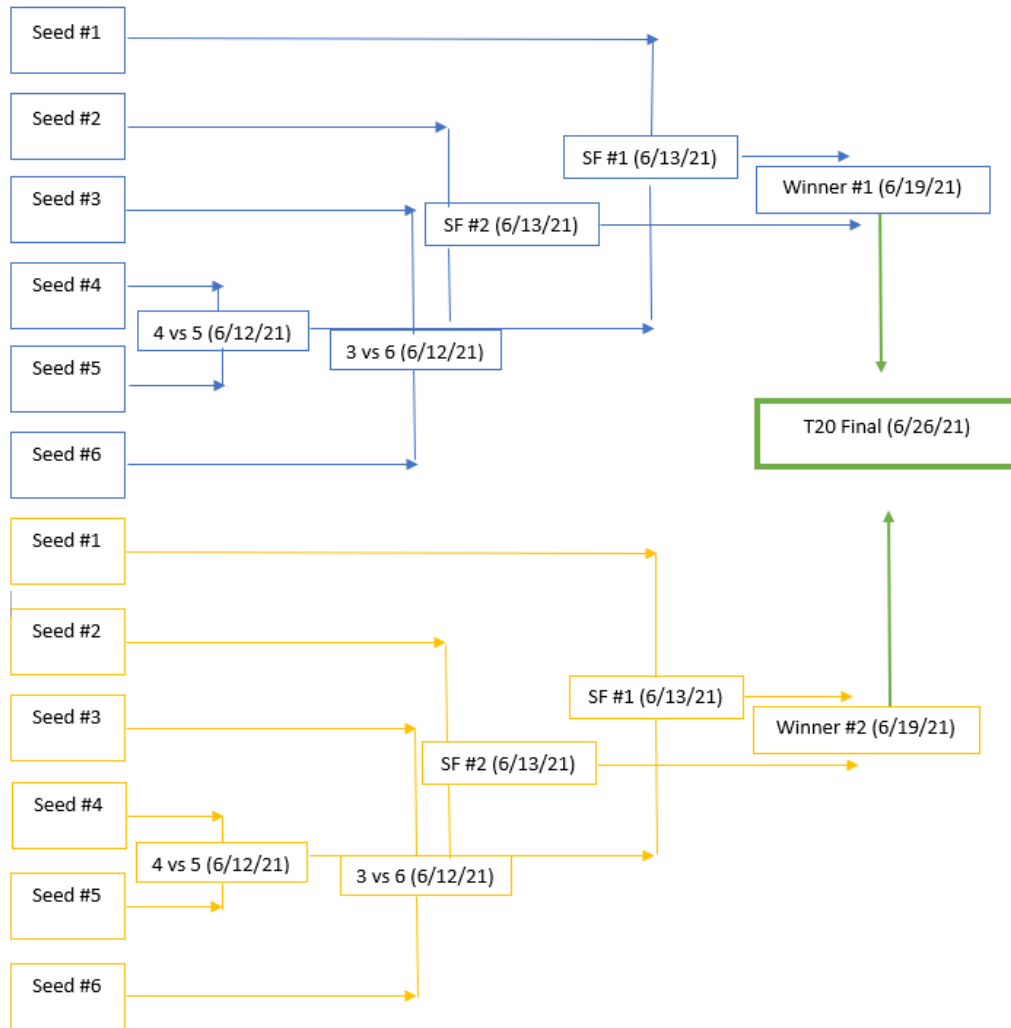
- i) Highest WIN percentage
- ii) Most Points (Win Points: 2, Washout/Draw /Tie Point: 1)
- iii) The Winner of the H2H match played between them
- iv) Highest Net Run Rate for completed matches
- v) Most Wins

2.1.3. The Conference Winners are the teams with the highest Overall Rank within their conference. These teams will receive a Playoff Rank of 1, 2, 3 and 4 in order of their Overall Rank.

2.2. Playoff Structure



Reserve Days: 6/20/21, 6/27/21

2.3. Quarter-Finals & Semi-Finals

2.3.1. If Quarter-Final and Semi-Final game is tied, the teams shall compete in a Super Over to determine which team advance to the next round.

2.3.2. There will be a reserve day for Quarter-Final and Semi-Final games

2.3.3. If weather conditions prevent the Quarter-Finals and Semi-Finals game from being completed on the reserve day, the team with the highest Overall Rank shall advance to the next round.

2.4. Final

2.4.1. If the Final is tied, the teams shall compete in a Super Over to determine the winner.

2.4.2. If weather condition prevents the Final from being completed, there is a reserve day on which the match will be played in its entirety.

2.4.3. If the match is not able to be completed on the reserve day as well, the teams shall be declared joint winners.

2.5. WMCB T20 Trophies

2.5.1. The Winner of the Final shall be awarded the WMCB T20 Tournament Trophy.

2.5.2. The Runner-up of the Final shall be awarded the WMCB T20 Runner-up Trophy.

2.5.3. In the case that the final cannot be completed due to weather events, the winner's trophy will be shared by both the teams.
